BMC partners with National Burns Centre in Airoli to treat patients

THE BRIHANMUMBAI Municipal Corporation (BMC) is collaborating with the National Burns Centre in Airoli, Navi Mumbai, to treat burn patients in the city. It is part of BMC's long-pending project to upgrade and expand its burn units.

In 2014, a proposal was first floated for upgrading two burn injury wards in Kasturba and Sion hospital, and of creating a new unit in Dr RN Cooper hospital. The project continues to face civic work delay. "The construction of new burns unit is underway. We will have separate isolation section and intensive care units for burn patients," said Kasturba Hospital's Superintendent Dr Chandrakant Pawar. Kasturba will have 25 beds after renovation, while Sion hospital has 15 and Cooper Hospital will set up 10 beds. While the proposal for these three centres was sanctioned in 2014, Cooper Hospital is yet to form a burns unit.

"The process is ongoing. We will take suggestions from the National Burns Centre before setting up our unit," said Dr Ganesh Shinde, dean at Cooper Hospital.

At least six centres will be developed as specialised burn care units with state-of-the-art infrastructure to treat critical burn patients, officials said

For a city that witnesses over 2,000 burns cases in a year, there are hardly 100 beds in government hospitals. The 15-bedded burns ward in Sion Hospital suffers from susceptibility to infection due to the open ward and beds lined in close proximity to one another. In most cases, critical patients are referred to Airoli where NBC has a specialised 50-bedded facility. The hospital follows American Burn Association and European Burn Association guidelines to treat acute burn victims.

"A burns centre needs huge funding. BMC asked us to collaborate with them and run a specialised centre in Mumbai.

In the recent chopper crash in Aarey Colony, Vrinda Modi who suffered injuries was referred to NBC a week after she was treated in a public-private partnership Seven Hills hospital for burns. According to BMC officials, the six centres will have state-of-the-art infra-

structure to manage infection control, plastic surgery and isolation for critical burn patients.

Our governing body will take a call on whether it is feasible," said director Dr Sunil Keswani. BMC will either retain the institute as an advisory body or use its help in treating patients. 8 shops raided for illegal drug sale for pets

Mumbai: The Maharashtra Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has raided and seized drugs worth Rs 4.4 lakh from eight shops in Mumbai, Pune and Thane after getting a lead on illegal sale of drugs for pet ani-

mals. In Mumbai, five shops in Andheri, Goregaon, Kandivli, Kandivli's Lokhandwala township and Santacruz were involved in the unlicensed sale. According to FDA's assistant commissioner Madhuri Pawar,

the shops had no licence to sell medication for pets. Tablets, ear drops and oral suspensions were being sold for pets which are categorised under Schedule H and X drugs. "Moreover, these drugs need

prescription for sale," said Pawar. Apart from Mumbai, two shops were raided in Thane and one in Pune. FIRs have been registered against each shop owners, an FDA official said. **ENS**

PUNE LAND DEAL

ACB to probe graft case against Khadse

High Court asks agency to register FIR immediately after taking over probe

THE MAHARASHTRA government told the Bombay High Court on Wednesday that the state's Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) would probe the Pune land deal case in which former minister and BJP leader Eknath Khadse is alleged to have misused his position. The government also said that the ACB would register an FIR against Khadse over allegations of corruption. The court has now directed the ACB to carry out the probe independently under the supervision of its Additional Director General. It has also asked for the FIR to be filed without delay.



Eknath Khadse

has alleged that Khadse misused his position as Revenue Minister and purchased a 3-acre plot in Bhosri near Pune in the name of his kin for Rs 3.75 crore when the market price was Rs 40 crore. After petitioner's counsel, Shrinivas Patwardhan, informed the court that Pune police have closed the case, state counsel Niteen Pradhan said that the

case would be transferred to the ACB. The court has now directed Pune police to withdraw its closure of the case, and transfer the case to the ACB within a week.

"The probe should be conducted expeditiously and independently. The investigations should not be influenced by the findings of the Pune police. The agency should not be influenced by the findings of the judicial commission either," said Justice More. Pradhan initially objected to registering an FIR immediately by the agency stating the agency's probe will be an honest one and that an FIR can be registered after the completion of prima facie probe. The court, however, directed the agency to register FIR immediately after taking over the probe. The HC will also monitor the progress of the case, which has been posted for next hearing on April 3.

A senior officer from Pune branch of the state ACB said, "We have not yet received any communication from the state department. But if we are entrusted to carry out the probe, we will begin with filing an FIR under Prevention of Corruption Act. The decision to entrust the probe to a particular ACB branch will be taken at the level of Home Ministry. The investigation of this gravity will be done under supervision of the senior officer."

Speaking over the development, Khadse said police's affidavit in the court had exonerated him. "They took six months and checked every document possible. As they did not find any illegality they filed the affidavit," said Khadse. He refused to comment over the court's directive to hand over the case to the ACB. Gawande, meanwhile, said: "I have full faith in the judiciary."

DSc honour for Mohan Bhagwat

THE MAHARASHTRA Animal and Fisheries Sciences University (MAFSU) in Nagpur has decided to confer its first-ever Doctorate of Sciences (DSc) degree on Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) Sarsangchalak Mohan Bhagwat, who is a veterinary doctor by training.

The honour will be bestowed on him here at the convocation of the university by Maharashtra Governor C H Vidyasagar Rao. Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis and Union Minister for Transport and Shipping Nitin Gadkari will also be present on the occasion. The university has considered factors such as his being an alumnus of the Nagpur Veterinary College and his social contribution as the basis for selecting Bhagwat for the first DSc honour.

Talking to The Indian Express, MAFSU Vice Chancellor A K Mishra said, "He is our alumnus and a veterinarian. He has promoted organic farming and setting up of goshalas (cow shelters) and has also written many books. He has also contributed to protection of indigenous cattle breeds." Mishra added, "He has contributed a lot in conservation of indigenous cattle and cow-based economy. It's also a mandate of constitution." Mishra said Bhagwat has written books on issues of social concerns. "We have also taken Bhagwat's immense social contribution into consideration," he added. The university was set up in 2000.

No evidence of EVM tampering, says SEC

MAHARASHTRA STATE Election Commissioner J S Saharia Thursday said there was no evidence of any tampering in Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) during the recently concluded local body polls across the state. With the BJP sweeping the polls, Opposition parties had raised doubts over malfunctioning EVMs. With many losing candidates raising the concern, the SEC was forced to address it.

In a meeting of representatives of registered political parties at the SEC office in Mumbai, Saharia said tampering of EVMs was not possible. "Adequate precautions were taken while manufacturing the EVMs. It is not possible to tamper with these machines," Saharia said.

The commissioner claimed he had held discussions with the management of the Electronic Corporation of India Ltd — which manufactures the EVMs — as well as domain experts who had assured him that it was not possible to tamper with the machines.

Elections for 10 Municipal Corporations and Zilla Parishads across Maharashtra took place last month. Bhiwandi-Nizampur, Malegaon, Latur, Parbhani, Chandrapur and Panvel Municipal Corporations will go to polls next.

Nagpur-Mumbai Expressway work to begin in Oct this year

THE STATE government has decided to start work on the Nagpur-Mumbai Super Communication Expressway from October this year. The eight-lane project comprising 25 townships, called the Maharashtra Prosperity Corridor, will be completed over a period of 36 months.

The government has tied up with financial institutions for the Rs 24,363-crore equity required for the civil construction of the 706-km road between Nagpur and Mumbai.

Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Wednesday dis-

cussed the financial model and steps to expedite the project that promises to bridge the urban-rural divide through agro-industries.

To be built under the land-pooling model, the total land required for the project is 10,463 hectares, of which 9,500 hectares is private land and the rest 963 hectares government or forest land. Consent has been obtained for 45 per cent of the total land.

A highly placed source told *The Indian Express*, "The conservative estimate of toll revenue for the project in the first year of its operation is estimated at Rs 1,082 crore."

This is substantially on the lower side for a 706-km Nagpur-Mumbai road, as compared to the Mumbai-Pune Expressway,

which is expected to earn Rs 1,035 crore in the same year for a 95-km stretch. The project will be implemented by a special purpose vehicle (SPV), a subsidiary of the Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation.

To meet the equity requirements and cash shortfall during the initial period of the project, the MSRDC has decided to monetise the land parcels. The sale of the available Bandra land area of 12 acres will generate Rs 14,400 crore; Napeensea Road area of 1.5 acres Rs 1,800 crore; MPEW land of 1,000 acres Mumbai-Pune Expressway Rs 2,000 crore.

The project cost and means of finance is as under: Land acquisition Rs 5,500 crore debt / civil construction Rs 24,363 crore

equity / node development Rs 2,500 crore / utility shifting insurance and contingency Rs 768 crore / IDC and financing costs Rs 4,485 crore. The total project cost is estimated at Rs 37,833 crore.

The debt for the project will be raised from banks / financial institutions under RBI guidelines dated July 15, 2014 for a door-to-door tenor of 28 years, including four years construction period of three years principal moratorium and 21 years of repayment. The initial tenor of the debt shall be for a shorter duration (10 years) at the end of which it shall be refinanced in line with the balanced amortization schedule. The MSRDC will hold at least 51 per cent equity share capital of the borrower during the tenor of debt.

Naik asks court to give him notice of pleas ED files against him

TELEVANGELIST ZAKIR Naik has approached the special PMLA court in Mumbai seeking that he be given notice of any plea the Enforcement Directorate (ED) files about him before it.

Naik has said in his plea that certain reports and statements in the press and in the remand application filed by the ED while seeking custody of his co-accused Aamir Gazdar say that Naik is avoiding taking part in the investigation. He says there are also reports claiming that the ED is taking steps to declare Naik an absconder and may approach the special Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) court to issue warrants against him.

Naik has claimed that "facts have been suppressed before the court" and he fears the agency would "misguide the court against him". The court is likely to hear the plea next week.

Meanwhile, Naik has also responded to the ED's summons through an email, seeking 15 days to gather the documents required of him by the agency.

Opposition leader's brother says his trust got donation from IRF

A MEDICAL trust of senior Congress leader Radhakrishna Vikhe Patil had received Rs 2 crore in donation from controversial preacher Zakir Naik's Islamic Research Foundation, his elder brother and educationist Ashok Vikhe Patil alleged on Wednesday.

Radhakrishna Vikhe Patil, the Leader of Opposition in the Maharashtra Legislative Assembly, is the vice-chairman of Pravara Medical Trust (PMT).

"Zakir Naik's IRF has given donation of Rs 2 crore to Pravara Medical Trust and this fact came to the fore during the investigation by the Enforcement Directorate (ED). Giving donation

is not illegal, but it is up to the recipient's conscience whether to accept it or not," Ashok said while addressing a press conference at Vikhe Patil School here.

Meanwhile, Radhakrishna has admitted that a medical college run by his trust had received "some funds" from Naik's IRF, which is currently banned under the UAPA Act. "I am one of the trustees and my (another) brother Rajendra looks after the daily functioning of the trust. He (Rajendra) told me today that IRF was one of the trusts that had given some funds to PMT. And it was for social cause, which we have utilised accordingly. Our education and other facilities to students are subsidised and like other funds, IRF's funds were also utilised for the same cause," he told PTI in Mumbai.

Radhakrishna said the PMT had all receipts of the funds received and have paid due taxes. "We can produce (receipts) if demanded," he said.

On the allegations, Radhakrishna said, "I am a bit hurt with my brother Ashok's statements against me and the organisation. I don't want to say more about the issue, as it is a bit personal matter as well."

Naik, the controversial Islamic preacher and tele-evangelist, is under the scanner of the Enforcement Directorate for alleged money laundering. The Centre had last November banned his Mumbai-based NGO for five years under the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act.

Yesterday, the National Investigation Agency (NIA) had served a notice to Naik.

IAS officer appointed Shirdi CEO

Mumbai: The state government has finally decided to appoint an IAS officer, Rubal Agarwal, as the Chief Executive Officer of the Shree Sai Baba Sansthan Trust, Shirdi. The moves comes after the Supreme Court on February

19 had confirmed the Bombay High Court directive to the state government that an IAS officer should govern the trust.

Agarwal is an officer of the 2008 batch and had been serving as district collector of Jalgaon. The

In Aurangabad, 148-kg woman looks to crowdfund her obesity surgery

FOR 38-YEAR-OLD Zeenath Khan, the International Women's Day was like any other day, spent stressing over a crowd-funding initiative through which she hopes to fund her obesity surgery. The Aurangabad-based woman weighs over 148 kg and suffers from a genetic disorder that has led to the uncontrolled weight gain.

Over the past two months, Khan has approached local corporators, MLAs and social organisations after doctors told her that bariatric surgery was the only option for her and would cost Rs 3 lakh in Mumbai. Her case is similar to Egyptian woman Eman Ahmed, who doctors suspect is victim of a genetic disorder. Ahmed is currently undergoing treatment in Mumbai through a massive crowd-funding campaign.

Khan has been able to raise only Rs 5,000 so far. "I have lost my job because of

my inability to move around," the mother of two claims. Doctors believe she has inherited obesity as there is such medical history in her family. In the past four years, despite a healthy and controlled diet, Khan's weight shot up, forcing her to remain home-bound most days. She suffers from breathlessness whenever she walks.

"I have constant joint pain and back pain. I can't walk anymore because of my weight," she says. When her weight did not decline after reducing food intake, Khan came to Mumbai to look for treatment. Before that, she had gone to several local doctors.

"What she needs is a sleeve gastrectomy. Her stomach size will reduce by 80 per cent and weight fall by 70 to 80 kg in a year," said bariatric surgeon Ramesh Goyal, though he warned that after such surgeries, patients need to continue a high-protein diet and a daily vitamin intake.

Khan's husband is a tailor and

earns Rs 3,000 per month. The family is unable to save any money for her surgery. Khan was formerly a schoolteacher, but had to quit when she could not stand for long hours in class. A graduate in fashion designing, she later joined a garment factory in Osmanabad as supervisor. "I left that job too as it required me to move around a lot," she says.

Now spending her days at home, Khan has created a Facebook page to draw attention towards the surgery she needs.

"My daughters keep asking me when I will get thin and start moving around again. It is embarrassing," she says. Her daughters, aged seven and nine years, have not inherited the genetic disorder.

According to Goel, over 60 per cent of obesity cases are inherited, in which monogenic disorders are easy to identify clinically. In some genetic disorders, only medication can help reduce weight.

BUDGET SESSION

Won't allow House to work if farm loans not waived: Oppn

LEADER OF Opposition Radhakrishna Vikhe Patil Tuesday said the Opposition would not allow the functioning of the Maharashtra Assembly from Thursday if the government did not announce loan waiver for farmers.

"The state government should bring in a one-line resolution on Thursday that it will make provisions for farm loan waiver in the budget. It this does not happen tomorrow, we will not allow the Assembly to function," Vikhe Patil told reporters on Tuesday.

The Congress leader said that since the BJP-led government came to power in 2014, nearly 9,000 farmers had committed suicide in the state.

"In January-February alone, as per my information, 262 farmers have committed suicide. Three years of drought, unseasonal rains and the absence of Minimum Support Price has affected them. Farmers are clearly not the priority for this government," Vikhe Patil said.

He added that even the government's allies, such as the Shiv Sena and the Swabhimani Shetkari Sanghatana, had spoken out against the way the it was treating farmers.

"This government has lost the confidence of the people as well as its own friends," Vikhe Patil said.

"The Shiv Sena joined us in the demand for loan waiver in the Lower House. We are amazed that the government says it will announce the loan waiver at an appropriate time. What time can be more appropriate than this?," he added.

Govt to suspend Paricharak

THE MAHARASHTRA government on Wednesday said it will take steps to ensure the suspension of legislative council member Prashant Paricharak and call an inquiry into his comments on wives of soldiers serving on the border, which many say were derogatory.

The Legislative Council Wednesday was disrupted for a third consecutive day with the Opposition demanding the suspension of Paricharak.

Paricharak is an independent MLC supported by the BJP. He had caused an uproar with his remarks at a rally in Solapur in the run-up to the local bodies elections last month. Legislative Council members are seeking his suspension for his remarks. The BJP, which is already facing flak in the lower house of the Maharashtra Assembly over loan waivers for farmers, has decided to accede to Oppositions demands.

"We have requested the house to set up a seven-member committee comprising members from all parties to look into the issue. Till the committee gives its report, Paricharak will remain suspended," said Maharashtra Revenue Minister Chandrakant Patil. Patil added that the report will be submitted in the present budget session.

Just 6 mills operational in state

THE SUGAR season in Maharashtra is all but over, with just six mills in operation. The short season, which will see the lowest sugar production in the last 10 years, has been exceptionally beneficial for farmers as mills have paid well over the fair and remunerative price; mills in Nanded division have ensured 100 per cent of their payments.

Starting under the shadow of two consecutive droughts, the

present sugar season has produced the lowest recorded sugar output in the state. Till date, 36,970 lakh tonnes (lt) of cane have been crushed and 41.65 lt of sugar produced. Before this, the lowest sugar production, of 46.14 lt, was seen in 2008-09.

Other than the short season, this year the sector has also seen multiple estimates about probable sugar production, the majority of which did not match up.

Of the 150 mills which had taken season, only two mills in Kolhapur division and four mills in Pune division remain opera-

tional. Mills in Nanded, Aurangabad, Aurangabad, Amravati and Nagpur have all closed operations. The six mills which are operational are from the cooperative sector.

As many as 117 sugar mills have paid 100 per cent of their dues. A short season and paucity of cane has come as a blessing for growers, most of whom have received payment well over the FRP. As against the total payable amount of Rs 7,979.68 crore, mills have paid Rs 8,323.84 crore. However, some of the mills have defaulted in payment.
